**MIDWEEK REFRESHER**

**READ:** John 14: 1-12

**REFLECT:** Who does not cherish the desire for a home, a harbor of peace and refreshment? Jesus announces his departure in terms of that human desire. He is going before his disciples to prepare a place for them. "I am the Way" is as strange a proclamation as "I am the Sheep gate" (John 10:7), but they help us examine the implications of the Easter experience. "You know the way that leads where I go" (John 14:4). We are sympathetic with the misunderstanding of Thomas and Philip. They would like to specify the road and identify the place where they will see the Father. But there is no need for a map. Jesus is the way to the way to the Father. We must follow him. Whoever has seen him has seen the Father. Jesus is the way, the truth and the life because he is one with God: hi is in the Father and the Father is in him. Authentic Christian faith is not anonymous. We cannot believe in a faceless God. Christianity teaches us to recognize God in the face of Jesus of Nazareth. By identifying his face in the disfigured faces of those whose suffering he bore on the cross, we find our dwelling place in him.

**PRAY:** Pray for the grace to recognize Jesus in the face of others.

**ACT:** Give some change to a homeless person you encounter this week. It is Jesus.

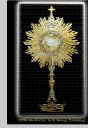
