**MIDWEEK REFRESHER**

**Read: Luke 9: 51-62**

**Reflect:** Three small stories of call illustrate the demands Jesus makes of his followers. In each case response requires renunciation. We must not base our faith on the material or psychological securities we have erected to protect ourselves from the furies of winter or vicissitudes of the soul. Nor can we put our assurance in a dead past. We would run the risk of perishing with it. We must keep our eyes on the road ahead, refusing to enter the future backwards. One image summarizes all this: the road along which Jesus calls his disciples to follow him. We must walk in the present, or better, in the presence of Jesus. Then we can discover life because we are led by the Spirit.

**Pray:** O God, I ask for the strength to face up to the daily challenges I must face because of my commitment to you.

**Act:** Ascertain which of the duties in life is most difficult for you. This time, carry it out with gusto.
