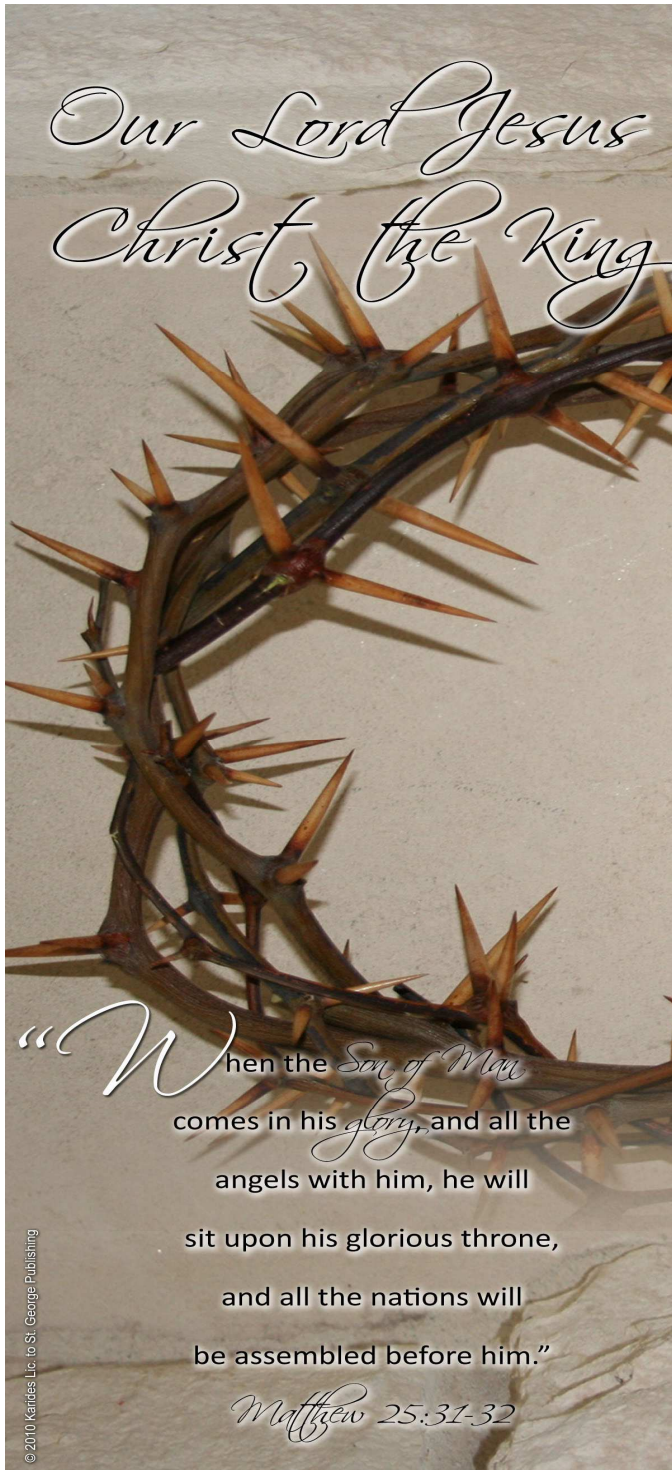

MIDWEEK REFRESHER

READ: Matthew 25: 31-46

REFLECT: The gospel draws our attention to the relationship between the end time and our life. Christ the King will preside over the judgment, whose outcome will be determined by our care for one another. We should not dream about heaven as an escape from present responsibility. We already live in the presence of the Son of Man. His special dwelling is among the needy. Our attention to him there opens us to his full revelation as the ruler and judge of the end time. This leads us to a more authentic understanding of Christ as King. To proclaim him king is not to demand a state religion. Jesus will claim his full title of King only at the hour of his coming in glory. But he lives now no less as king in a hidden way in the poor and the little ones. He is the defender of their rights and their appointed protector. In serving the poor we serve him.

PRAY: With the power of the Holy Spirit pray that you may recognize those in need.

ACT: Look for opportunities to meet Jesus' expectations in your daily life.

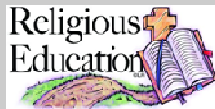
